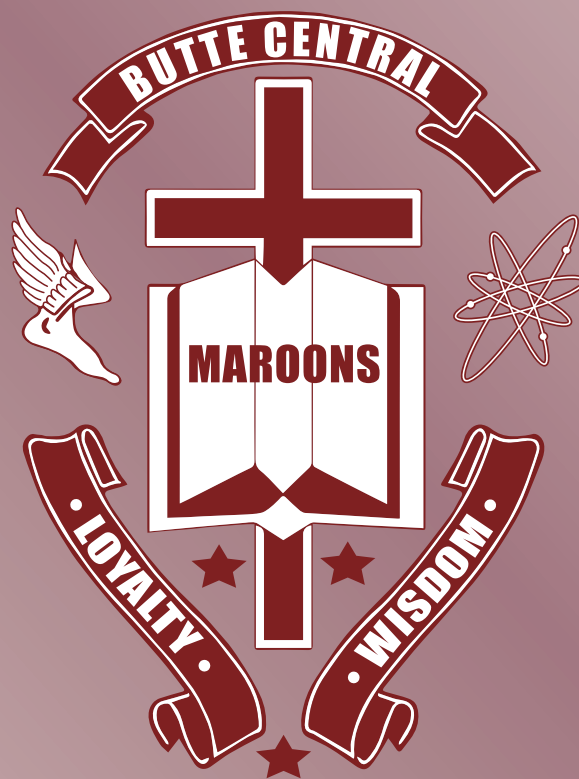

# BUTTE CENTRAL *Education Foundation*

The Butte Central Education Foundation serves as the cornerstone of fundraising in the Butte Central Catholic School System. Funds raised by the Foundation are used to meet the costs of education that are not covered by tuition and parish subsidies.

For the 2022-2023 school year included, the Foundation provided \$1,768,830 to Butte Central Schools. The funds included \$1,472,830 to fund school operations and \$296,000.00 in student scholarships.

In addition, the Foundation manages the Maroon Activities Center and raises future funds for scholarships, faculty and staff salaries, capital improvements, and academic resources.

Annually, the Butte Central Foundation conducts a variety of fundraising activities and events. The Annual Fund Drive and the Maroon Activities Association Drive play a major role in funding the Catholic education. The annual Butte Central Auction is another important project that generates funds for Butte Central Catholic Schools.

The Butte Central Education Foundation is blessed to have the tremendous support of alumni, parents, boosters, the Butte business community, and the Butte Catholic community.



# BUTTE CENTRAL *School Board*

The Butte Central Catholic School Board is responsible for the general operations of Butte Central Catholic Schools. The Board acts under the jurisdiction of the Diocese of Helena School Office and must adhere to school and Diocesan policies.

The Board is challenged with the responsibility of developing, formulating, and enacting policies that guide the Butte Central Catholic School System. The Board's policies cover personnel, secular curriculum, planning, finance, marketing, and public relations.

The Board membership includes regular voting members, ex-officio non-voting members, and four standing sub-committees. The sub-committees include the finance committee, education committee, Catholic culture, and marketing committee. The sub-committees are designed to provide expertise, recommendations, and advice to the regular voting members.

# MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT PROGRAM

*"Building for Tomorrow"*

The Memorial Endowment Program was created in 1989 to provide an opportunity for families, classes, and individuals to establish endowed funds in support of Butte Central Schools. The program is designed to create a perpetual source of revenue through investment of the donors' gift as well as an everlasting tribute and memorial. To establish an endowment, donors must commit a minimum of \$1,000 over a three-year period. The interest income from these endowments will fortify school finances by creating an annual source of revenue.

Three separate types of endowments, all with critical importance are part of the program.

1. **Memorial Endowments** – Provide revenue for unrestricted use by Butte Central Schools unless the donor wishes to restrict the funds to a special area or branch of the system.

2. **Memorial Endowed Scholarships** – Provide tuition assistance to Butte Central School system students and families. Selection criteria and requirements may be established if the donor desires.
3. **Memorial Endowed Faculty Chairs** – Provide an annual source of salary enhancement for faculty and staff.

The principal investment of these endowments has grown to over \$1,000,000. All funds are professionally managed. Plaques listing all endowments are on permanent display in the rotunda of Butte Central High School. Each year, a listing of all endowments is published in the Butte Central Schools Annual Report to further honor those remembered by endowments.

## *Memorial Endowments*

Providing funds for unrestricted use by the Butte Central Catholic School System. Special programs or area may be specified by the donor.

**Alexander and Virginia Delaney Endowment** – Established in memory of Alexander Delaney by his wife Virginia Delaney.

**Badovinac Family Endowment** – Established by John & Janet (Lynch) Badovinac (Class of 1963) in honor of their family and dedication to Butte Central.

**Carl Ueland Family Endowment** – Established by Carl Ueland of Fresno, California (Class of 1966) in honor of the Ueland family.

**Class of 1939 Cheerleader Memorial Fund** – Established by Kevin T. Cadigan of Seaside, Oregon (Class of 1939). The endowment was established to benefit the BC Cheerleading Program as a memorial to his wife Danita (McCarthy) Cadigan who was a cheerleader at Butte Central. The endowment also honors the other members of the cheerleading squad, Ann (Sullivan) Nettles and Mary Elizabeth "Sis" (Gleason) Scott.
